

ICCS STRING ORCHESTRA for FALL 2015

Classical string orchestra classes will be offered again during the school day on Mondays and Wednesdays, taught by Mrs. Delta Holl. Students are introduced to orchestra strings through note reading, rhythms, tone production and ensemble playing. The best progress is made by those who review at home what we introduce and work on in class.

Families are responsible for providing a violin, viola (with bow and shoulder rest), or cello (with bow and endpin stop) in the appropriate size for the child. Fourth and fifth grade students need to buy *Essential Elements 2000, Book 1*, for their instrument. Grades 6-8 students need to buy *Essential Elements 2000, Book 2*, for their instrument and provide a 3-ring binder with 10 page protectors. These are the basic items to bring to each class. At home, a quiet area to play and practice, set up with a chair and music stand, will be a big help to your student.

This enrichment class carries a fee for each student of **\$240.00** for the fall term, non-refundable, and **payable to ICCS by Wednesday, August 19, 2015**. Your child is registered for String Class when payment is received by Mrs. White, Bookkeeper.
